

JRE Establishes Japan Renewable Energy Scholarship Fund

Japan Renewable Energy Corporation ("JRE"; headquartered in Minato-ku, Tokyo; Kazuhiro Takeuchi, President and CEO) has set up a scholarship fund aimed at high school students living in seven Japanese municipalities where the JRE Group's wind farms and a biomass power plant are located, and has started to invite applications from such students.

The purpose of the scholarship fund is to provide the financial aid (scholarships) to students for their studies in high school through Koeki Suishin Kyokai, a public interest incorporated foundation, in order to provide support for the development of next generation talent in their respective region. Students are not required to repay this scholarship and no obligations are imposed as to future employment or the like and can combine this scholarship with any other scholarships.
