

Japan Renewable Energy Corporation Highly Evaluated by GRESB Infrastructure Assessment

Japan Renewable Energy Corporation ("JRE") has been highly evaluated by the 2022 GRESB Infrastructure Asset Assessment.

1. Results of the Assessment

Japan Renewable Energy Corporation took part in the GRESB Infrastructure Asset Assessment for the fifth consecutive year from 2018 and received the GRESB rating of "Four-Star", a high evaluation for overall environmental, social and governance (ESG) activities.

In particular, JRE was highly evaluated for the organizational leadership to promote and manage ESG, production of renewable energy and contribution to reduction of CO2 emission, management for health and safety of employees and contractors, ESG treatments for employees and ESG disclosure.

JRE will continue to accelerate ESG related activities and enhancing information disclosure.



2. About GRESB Infrastructure

GRESB, the Global ESG Benchmark for Real Assets, is an annual benchmarking

assessment to measure ESG integration of real estate companies and funds. It was

founded in 2009 by a group of European institutional investors who played leading roles

in launching Principles for Responsible Investment (PRI). There are 170 "investor

members" representing USD 51 trillion in asset under management using GRESB data

upon their investment decision-making and engagement processes with investees. DBJ

(Development Bank of Japan Inc) has actively supported GRESB since its early stage as

an Investor Member and GPIF (Government Pension Investment Fund) joined in 2020.

GRESB Infrastructure was launched in 2016 and consists of two assessments of "Fund

Assessment" and "Asset Assessment". This year, 652 assets or entities participated in

the Asset Assessment, which evaluates infrastructure assets.

Each participant receives a "GRESB Rating" of five grades from "One-Star" to the highest

"Five- Star", based on the rank order of evaluation results among all participants.
